

Flu Vaccine Information

Flu vaccine is available at both of our offices. If your child has an appointment for well child care, you can plan to receive the vaccine at that time and do not need to make an appointment in one of our flu vaccine clinics.



If you would like an appointment in one of our flu vaccine clinics please call your primary office Monday - Friday 8:30am - 5:00am to book with us.

CDC's Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) has recommended that certain groups of the population receive the Influenza vaccine when it first becomes available:

- pregnant women,
- people who live with or care for children younger than 6 months
- healthcare and emergency medical services personnel,
- persons between the ages of 6 months and 24 years old,
- people ages of 25 through 64 years of age who are at higher risk for 2009 H1N1 because of chronic health disorders or compromised immune systems.

***Children under 9 years old will need two doses of the vaccine one month apart unless they have had a total of two doses of flu vaccine since July of 2010.*

***Please note however if your child is allergic to eggs you should talk to your pediatrician before scheduling the vaccine.*
